ANNIVERSARY OF THE MIRACLE OF THE FIRE & APPARITION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

On the evening of October 8, the anniversary of the Great 1871 Fire, the Shrine will hold all-night adoration with hourly rosary processions around the Shrine's grounds. Mass is held the following day to commemorate Our Lady's appearance to Adele on October 9, 1859.



ADVENT RORATE CAELI MASS

2ND SATURDAY IN DECEMBER

Join the National Shrine in Champion for its celebration of the Rorate Caeli Mass, an ancient liturgy honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary! The event begins in the darkness of the morning and, as Mass is celebrated in Candlelight, the Sun rises and illumines the chapel. Breakfast and a special Advent reflection by the Fathers of Mercy will follow Mass.

EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLES EXHIBIT

The National Shrine will be displaying the Eucharistic Miracles of the World, an International exhibit designed and created by Blessed Carlo Acutis, for pilgrims and parish groups to draw into a deeper encounter with Christ in the Eucharist. The exhibit includes 153 panels that present photographs and historical descriptions of the Eucharistic Miracles that took place throughout the ages around the world.



SPIRITUAL MOTHERHOOD CONFERENCE

On the weekend leading up to Mother's Day, Champion Shrine will host a special event centered around the Spiritual Motherhood of Mary. This event brings women together to equip them in the teaching of sharing in Mary's motherhood for souls, especially Priests.
